The battlefield of the Copenhagen streets and the creation of a bicycle city

1940s: Copenhagen was a city of cyclists with up to 400,000 people riding their bikes in and out of the centre every day.



1960s: As a result of the suburbanization of the 60s, cars took over as the main mode of transportation. Bicycle lanes were cancelled to make room for car parks.




1980s: The bicycle lanes were reclaimed in the streets, once again separating the bicycles from cars. This marks the beginning of Copenhagen's second bicycle era.







Public transportation: train, Metro, and bus routes.




